### OUR ACTION STEPS

- + No health insurance coverage

We do have a no show policy that if you do not show up when your turn is called 2 visits in a row, you will no longer be eligible to use our service.
- We are not a primary care or follow up care facility. We do not carry prescription medications on site and we will not prescribe Schedule 2 medications. If you have a condition that requires higher level medications, please see your doctor or the Emergency Department.
- We do not carry prescriptions or cash on site.
- We do not accept any form of insurance, Medicaid, or Medicare.
